TULSA CITY GOVERNMENT

AN OVERVIEW

In February, 1989, Tulsa voters approved the most sweeping changes in city government in more than 80 years. A Mayor-Council form was chosen to replace an outdated City Commission. Tulsa's elected officials are nine City Councilors, the Mayor, and the City Auditor.

The legislative functions of Tulsa City Government are performed by the City Council. It approves the city's annual budget, passes local ordinances, sets City policy, listens to concerns and suggestions from citizens, and evaluates the overall effectiveness of City operations.

The City Council meets at 6:00 p.m. each Thursday, except for holidays, in the Francis Campbell City Council Room located on the Civic Center Plaza in downtown Tulsa (adjacent to City Hall). The public is invited and encouraged to attend the Thursday meetings as well as all Council Committee meetings (held each Tuesday - schedule provided on the back of this brochure).

All City Councilors have offices on the 2nd floor of City Hall, and are assisted in their duties by Council Staff and by various citizens' committees. Office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. City Councilors can also be reached by e-mail through the City Council website (see information on the left).

Tulsa's Mayor heads the administrative branch of government, managing the day-to-day operations of the City of Tulsa.

The City Auditor regularly reviews the City's financial activities for efficiency, effectiveness, and legality. Findings of any investigations are reported to the Mayor and the City Council.

Your voice in Tulsa city government is the Tulsa City Council, and your voice always counts!

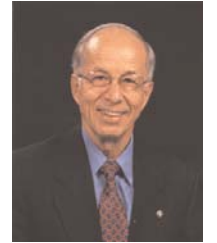

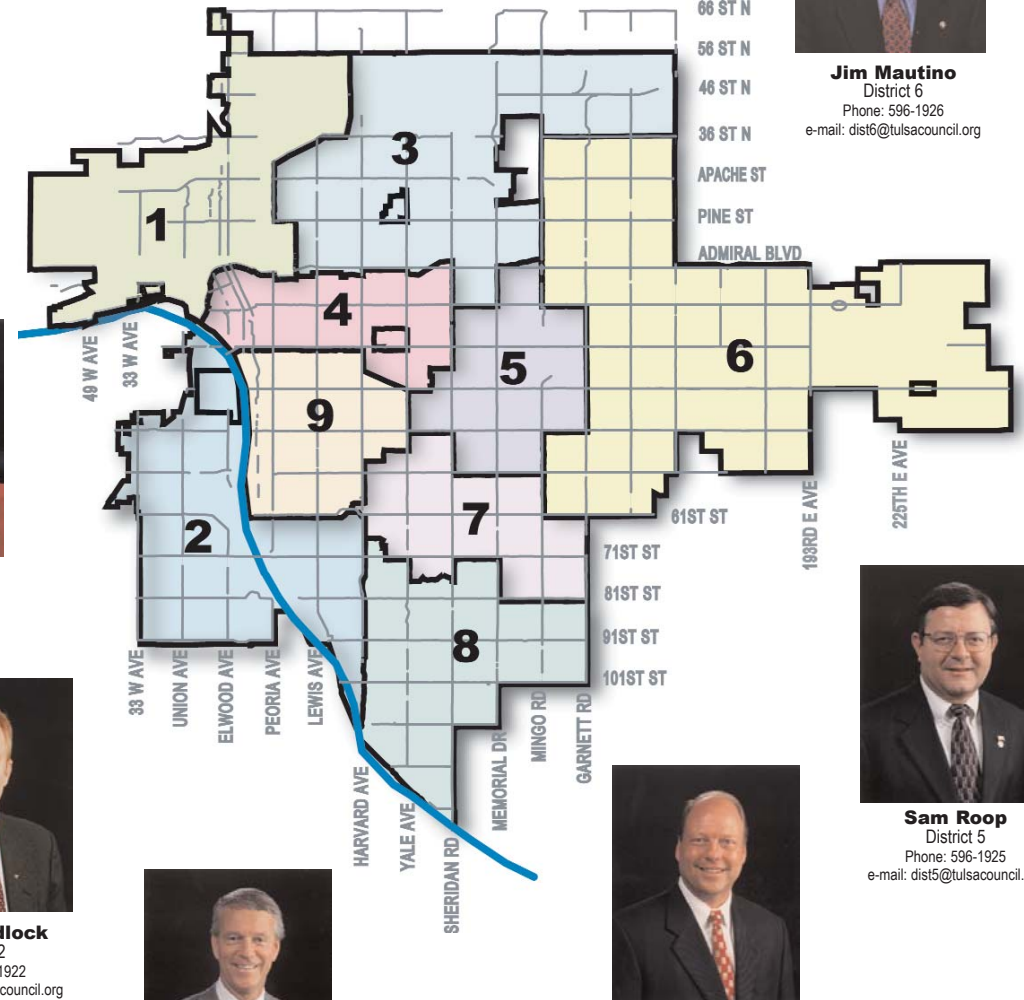
